ADAM'S RUN HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

Adam's Run Homeowners' Association consists of a 11 member Board of Directors. The board usually meets on a Thursday of every other month at the Teamster's Local 783 Hall at 7711 Beulah Church Road. Meetings begin at 7 pm and are open to all residents of Adam's Run. Since the location is subject to change please watch for signs posted at the two entrances and the website for details.

Garbage Disposal

There are several options for waste disposal in the Adams Run Community. However, the board has negotiated a special rate and service plan for residents with Industrial Disposal. Currently service with Industrial Disposal is \$36 quarterly, which includes two junk pickup days per year in addition to one large item; ie a couch, being picked up per week at no additional charge. Discounted service rates are also available for recycling and yard waste. Please call 638-9000. This contracted rates renewal is contingent upon 80% of the neighborhood choosing Industrial Disposal for their garbage disposal and is subject to increase in the next contracted period if 80% of the neighborhood does not utilize their service.
